3 on 3 Basketball Tournament Rules

- 1. The tournament has a double elimination format; teams are guaranteed 2 games.**
- 2. Teams will consist of three players, with no more than four. Players may play on only one team.**
- 3. Maximum of five minute warm-up/rest between games. Boys and girls divisions will be separate if numbers allow. Co-ed teams will be placed in the boys division.**
- 4. Teams must check in on tournament day 30 minutes before the first scheduled game.**
- 5. No dunking/hanging on the rims at all times. PENALTY: Disqualification.**
- 6. Teams must be at their assigned court at the scheduled game time. A five minute forfeit rule will be enforced.**
- 7. All games can start and end with any number of players on the court (1,2 or 3)**
- 8. Initial ball possession will be determined by a coin toss.**
- 9. Possession will change after each score. Upon a possession change, the offensive team must allow the defensive team to ‘check’ the ball at the head of the circle beyond the three-point line.**
- 10. After ‘checking’ the ball, the ball is LIVE. No need to pass the ball in. When the defensive team gets the ball by either a steal or rebound, they must take the ball behind the three-point line at any point before attacking the basket on offense. ALL Changes of possession MUST be taken BACK! (i.e. air ball)**
- 11. There will be no lane violations; no 3 seconds in the key.**
- 12. Player substitution is permitted during any dead-ball situation.**
- 13. Each team will be allowed one 30 second time out. The clock does not stop running. A time out may not be permitted during the last two minutes of the game.**
- 14. Call your own fouls. Severe incidents will result in player ejection. . If play is rough. An official MAY be assigned to each game to call fouls, violations and to control the game. His/her word is final.**
- 15. Technical fouls may be called for rough & unsportsmanlike play. 1st-Technical: 2 points and the ball; second technical is disqualification.**
- 16. No trash talking, taunting, swearing or fighting will be permitted. Each team will be given one warning and a technical foul. The next time will result is the team forfeiting the game. Remember GOOD SPORTS ARE WINNERS.**
- 17. Winners will be the first team to score H.S.: 15 points with a two point advantage; M.S. and below 12 points with a two point advantage.**
- 18. Games will have a 20 minute time limit. The team ahead by a two-point margin at that time will be declared the winner.**
- 19. If the event of a tie score, sudden death is in effect. A coin flip will determine procession.**
- 20. A field goal counts as one point. A goal from behind the 3-pont arc is worth two points. The player shooting must have both feet completely behind the line when initiating the attempt.**
- 21. Standard procedures for open wounds/abrasions. A First aide kit will be available.**
- 22. First place and second place teams in each division will receive awards.**
- 23. Entry fee is non-refundable.**
- 24. Organizers reserve the right to modify tournament schedule due to weather or combine divisions due to team numbers.**
